# **Dual Admissions Program**

#### What is Dual Admissions?

• The Dual Admissions Program is an advising program that gives students the opportunity to convert an associate degree into a baccalaureate degree at Shippensburg University.

#### When can I enroll?

• You can enroll as early as your senior year of high school, <u>but no later than the</u> completion of 30 college level credit hours.

How do I enroll in Dual Admissions?

#### **Enroll in 3 easy steps:**

- 1. Complete the dual admissions enrollment form located on the next page.
- Complete the Shippensburg University application located on the dual admissions website at the link below (No application fee required). (http://www.ship.edu/Admissions/Transfers/Dual\_Admissions\_FAQ/
- 3. Return the dual admissions enrollment form and Shippensburg University application to your community college advisor and/or dual admissions coordinator.

#### What is my next step?

- Your advisor will forward your dual admission enrollment form and official application to the Shippensburg University Office of Admissions, along with a copy of your transcript.
- After your information is reviewed, you will receive a packet in the mail from Shippensburg explaining the Dual Admissions Program in more detail.
