Canadian-born, Gordon Lightfoot is one of the most accomplished singer-songwriters today. Best known for his international hits "Sundown," "Wreck of The Edmund Fitzgerald," "If You Could Read My Mind," and "Early Mornin' Rain," his songs have been covered by such greats as Bob Dylan, Barbra Streisand, and Elvis Presley.



Lightfoot began his music career fronting a number of bands in Toronto, before he relocated to Los Angeles to write jingles, only to return to Toronto where he rapidly became a fixture in the growing folk music scene. Known for composing contemporary ballads that reflect the world in all its beauty, harshness, and poignancy, Lightfoot's songs touch listeners on many levels.

Lightfoot has had five Grammy nominations and has won 17 Juno Awards in his native Canada, as well as having received several prestigious awards for his contributions to Canadian culture.
