### **To maintain good standing in the Honors Program:**

1. Students must maintain a minimum 3.25 QPA overall and in their Honors courses.
2. Students are expected to enroll in at least 1 Honors course each semester until they have fulfilled the curricular requirements of the University Honors Program. Students who are not able to enroll in an Honors course must inform the Honors director.
3. Students must fulfill the Honors Program's participation requirement each year.

### **Special Note Regarding Study Abroad Credits:**

Students who study abroad may count up to 6 of their study abroad credits as Honors credits.
