BENJAMIN A. GILMAN INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Awards of up to \$5,000 to support U.S. citizen undergraduates receiving federal Pell Grant funding at two-year or four-year undergraduate colleges or universities in study abroad. Students studying a Critical Need Language may receive a \$3,000 supplement for at total possible award of \$8,000. This program is sponsored by the U.S. Department of State, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs.

BOREN SCHOLARSHIPS & FELLOWSHIPS

Funding from the National Security Education Program (NSEP) supports U.S. undergraduate and graduate students to study less commonly taught languages in world regions critical to U.S. interests: Africa, Asia, Central and Eastern Europe, Eurasia, Latin America, and the Middle East. Up to \$20,000 will be awarded to undergraduates and \$30,000 to graduate students depending on cost and length of program.

DEADLINE: January 31, 2013 for graduate students; February 13, 2013 for undergraduates
