

**Modern Languages – MINORS (18-27 credits)**

A minimum of 18 credit hours to a maximum of 27 credit hours is required for a minor depending on initial placement in the selected language. The program is divided between three/four required courses and two/three electives. Courses numbered below 200 do not count for the minors. All courses required for the minors are taught in the foreign language. Course substitutions may be applied. In such case, the proper paperwork must be filed in the dean's office.

**French Cultural Studies Minor**

The approach for this minor would be interdisciplinary and have less of a focus on language than the standard French minor and more on the culture, taught in English. The minor would be capped with a summer course in Quebec for culture and language immersion.

The distribution of the 18 credits would be as follows:

**Course in Quebec taught in English**

Readings would be assigned beforehand so that the students would see the relevance of the activities in Quebec. The students would be quizzed on site to verify understanding of the relevance. Other grades would come from a journal and a final paper to turn in two weeks upon return.

It would be advisable that out of state tuition be waived for the course which will not be taught in PA and will have a minimum use of PA resources.
