**Individuals not arrested but referred for possible campus disciplinary action.

Crime rate is calculated by dividing the total number of reported incidents by the number of full-time equivalent (FTE) undergraduate students, graduate students, and university employees. In 2006, for example, there were 27 burglaries reported; 27 divided by the total FTE (7,832) equals a crime rate of .0034.
