**RECORD OF LEVEL I FIELD EXPERIENCES
Self-initiated and Course-required**

Field experiences provide actual settings in which teacher candidates develop and demonstrate the **knowledge, skills and dispositions necessary to help all students learn**. "All" implies the possibility of diverse learning needs. Such needs may surface with (a) students having exceptionalities; (b) students from varying geographical areas, ethnicities, races, religions or socioeconomic strata; or (c) students with gender, sexual orientation and linguistic differences.

Level I Field Experiences require 60 or more hours in urban, suburban and rural locations and with students having diverse learning needs. *Total hours* are combined self-initiated and course-required experiences. *Settings* may include public and private schools, summer camps, and daycare, church and community organizations. *Activities* may include tutoring, focused observing, team teaching, interviewing, and coaching. *Satisfactory completion of Level I Field Experiences is required for Level One Professional Standing and admission to methods courses.*
