The Pennsylvania Cable Network will broadcast "The Little Red Schoolhouse" — an episode that was taped at the Mount Jackson Schoolhouse located on the Shippensburg campus — at the following times:

- 6 p.m. on Friday, November 25
- 2 p.m. on Saturday, November 26
- 10 a.m. on Monday, November 28

The program, taped on April 30, 2011 before a live audience, was part of an episode of *Humanities on the Road*, an arts and culture-themed television show presented by the Pennsylvania Humanities Council (PHC) and broadcast on PCN-TV. Shippensburg was selected from more than 75 organizations from across Pennsylvania to host the program presented by Dr. Jonathan Zimmerman, professor of education and history at New York University's Steinhardt School of Culture, Education and Human Development.
