Business Administration (MBA)

- Complete part-time in 2 years, taking 2 courses a semester, 1 night a week.
- Taught through personal contact, video-conferencing, and online instruction.
- From the AACSB-accredited John L. Grove College of Business.
- Offered at Synder's of Hanover Corporate Headquarters.

Advanced Studies in Business (Post-Bachelor's Certificate)

- 16-credit certificate program for professionals from various backgrounds
- Meets the needs of professionals who wish to earn an MBA but lack the necessary course pre-requisites.
- Complete part-time in 1 year, taking 1 course a semester, 1 night a week.
- Offered at Synder's of Hanover Corporate Headquarters.

Education

Master's in School Administration/Supervisory Certificate

- 33-credit cohort program allows students to earn both the M.Ed. in Educational Leadership and the Principal Certificate at the same time.
- Can be completed in two and a half years or less.
- Courses meet one evening per week for Fall/Spring semesters and two evenings per week during Summer terms. (Opportunities for weekend courses.)
- Courses consist of blended instruction (face-to-face and online).
- Offered at Lincoln Intermediate Unit, New Oxford

Post-master's Principal/Supervisory Certificate

- For those who have earned a master's degree and/or at least 15 graduate credit hours in subject field or educational specialist area.

Superintendent Letter of Eligibility

- Satisfies all Pennsylvania Department of Education standards governing the issuance of this certificate.
- Offered at Lincoln Intermediate Unit, New Oxford.
- All courses accepted toward the Widener Doctor of Education degree offered at Ship (see below).
- Evening and weekend courses.

Doctoral Program in Educational Leadership

- Shippensburg University has partnered with Widener University to bring this doctoral program to the Ship campus.
- Earn a Ed.D. in Educational Leadership from Widener and a Superintendent's Letter of Eligibility from Shippensburg.
- Coursework can be completed in two years with another for dissertation research.

Health Care

Health Care Administration (B.S.)

- Designed to meet the needs of the working adult who has 60 or more college credits.
- Core courses provide a solid foundation in the structure of organizations, the behavior and communication of individuals within organizations, conflict resolution.
- Professional courses provide opportunities to explore the legal, ethical, financial, resource, and strategic issues of health care management and administration.
- Elective courses challenge students to integrate theory and practice through an internship or independent study.
- At least two courses each semester offered at HACC-Gettysburg
