Employer Perspective

Accessing the Hidden Job Market

Experts agree that about **80%** of all jobs are filled without employer advertising. These positions are filled by candidates who come to an employer's attention through recommendations from employees, referrals from trusted associates, or direct contact with the candidate. Successful hidden job market candidates are able to connect with the employer's network. Does this mean the employer knows them? Not necessarily. But the candidate comes "pre-recommended" by someone the employer trusts.

How do you access the Hidden Job Market?

1. Networking

- Your current contacts, or those people you meet through your contacts can help you learn about positions, projects, or needs at companies that will not be formally announced. Employers are constantly on the lookout for suitable candidates to replace departing, retiring or inefficient workers. Using the people you know and the people they know will help you find the employers who need your skills. Your contacts can help get your resume to the top of the pile to be reviewed.
- Shippensburg University Alumni can also be very helpful! Talking with people who are in the career field you want to work in can get you started on learning where the jobs are. In addition, they can help solidify your resume for that career field.
- Meet more people for networking through professional organizations. Professional organizations are a great way to expand your personal network and meet people interested in the same career fields as you.
- Get in touch with former bosses, faculty members, internship supervisors, etc. They can often be helpful when conducting a job search. The more people who know what you are looking for and have a copy of your resume, the more interviews you will get.
- Use your local Chamber of Commerce. They have an excellent business directory for your list below and also offer "networking" happy hour events. You can find your Chamber of Commerce at <http://www.chamberofcommerce.com>

2. Direct Contact of Companies

Go back to your list of companies that you want to work for and contact them. Call and find out who the hiring person is and send them your cover letter and resume inquiring about potential job opportunities.

Keys to be effective:

- Address your resume and cover letter to the hiring person
- Indicate in your cover letter how you can benefit their company (this will require some research)
- Follow up with a phone call after you mailed out your resume and cover letter- try to get an appointment to see someone.
- If they have nothing open at this time, stay in touch with them. You never know when they might have something come open.
