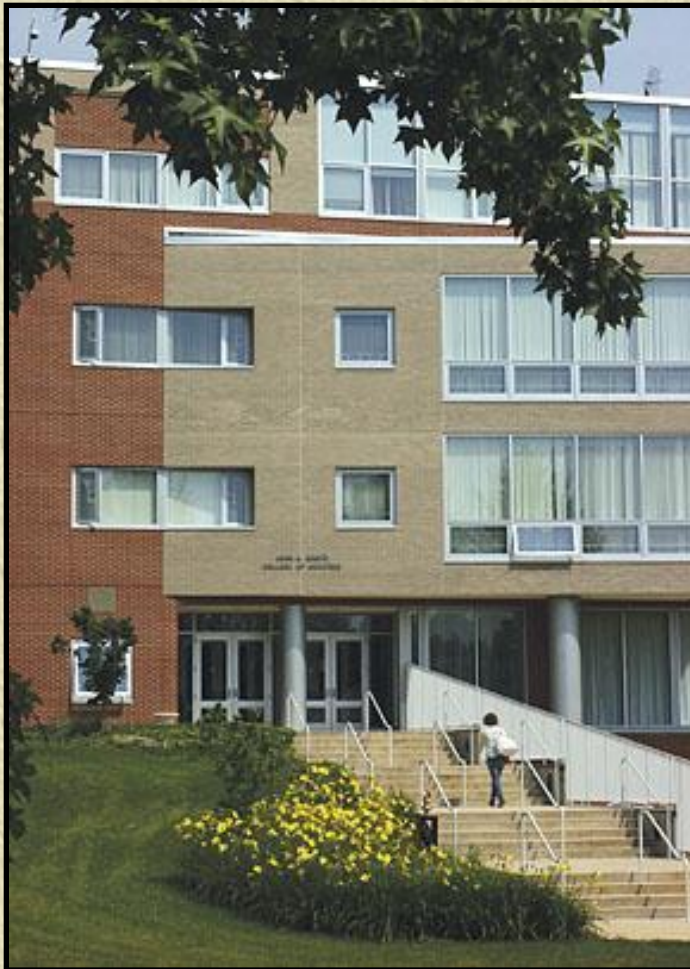

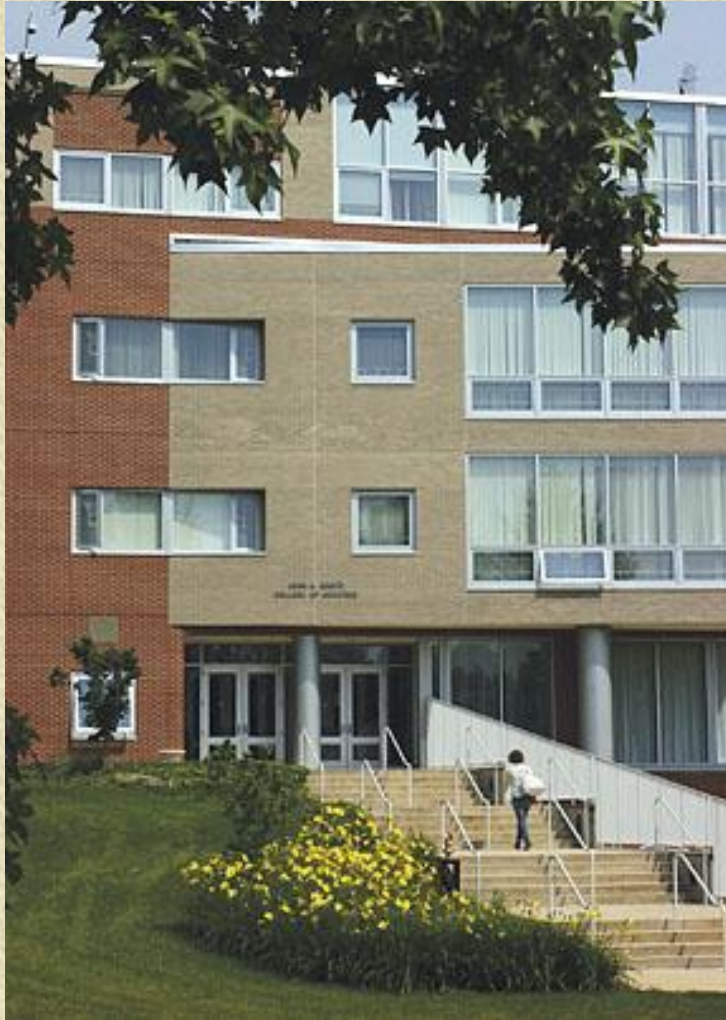

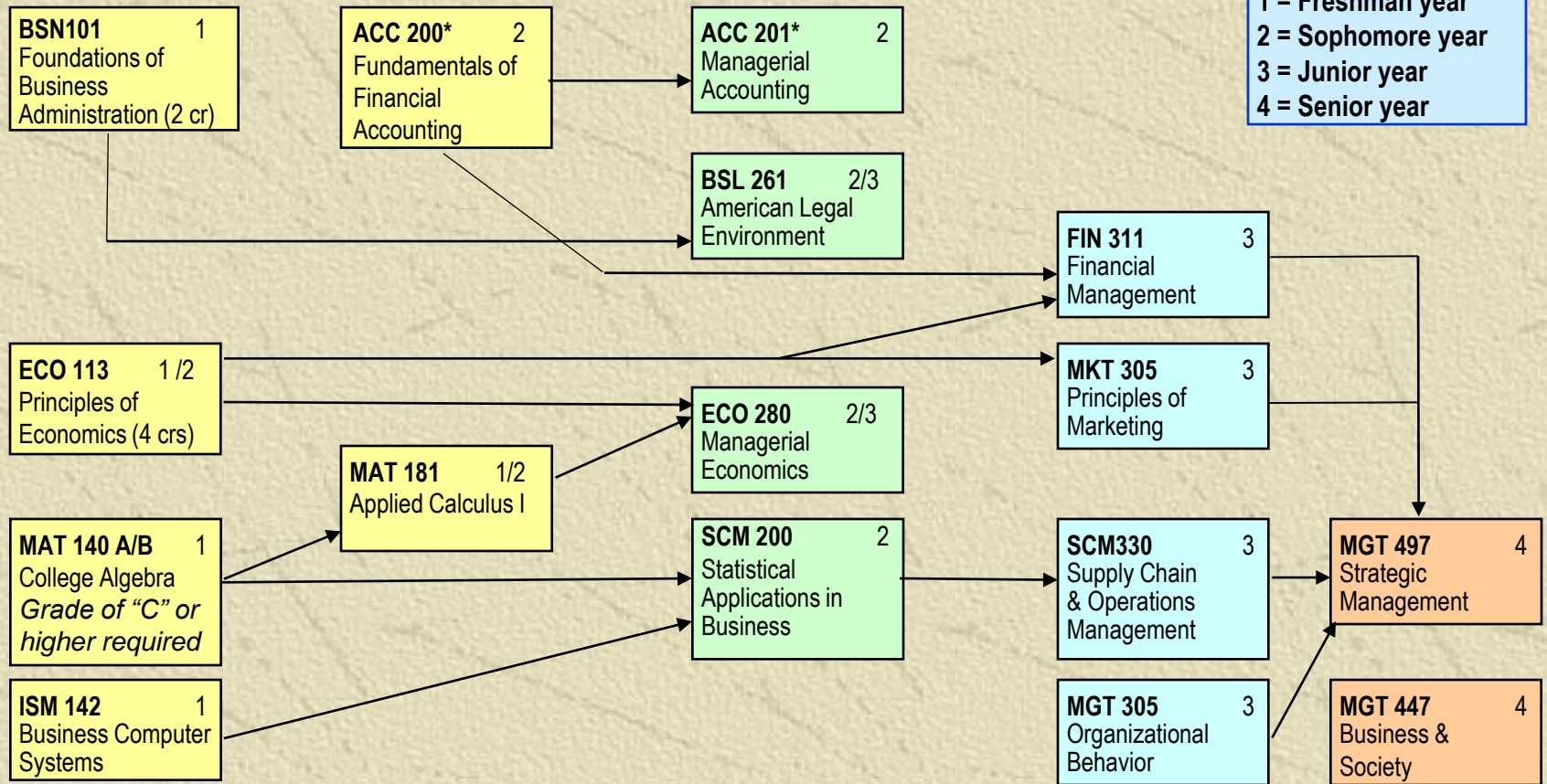

 Complete English 106 Writ Int First Yr Sm or equivalent with a "C" grade or better;
 Maintain a 2.0 cumulative average in the business core, the major, and a 2.0 cumulative average overall.

* Accounting majors should take ACC 200 in their first semester and ACC 201 in the second semester of their sophomore year and earn at least a "C" grade or higher in both courses.

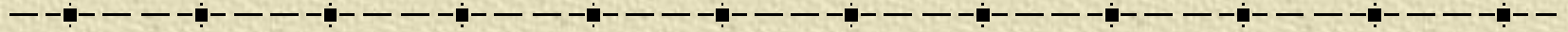

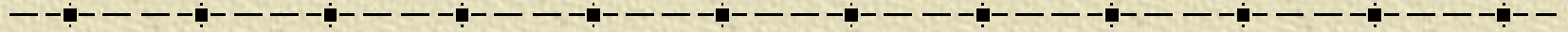

- Participate in required AACSB assessment activities – e.g., Sophomore Interviews, Senior Exit Interviews, and Senior Exit Exams

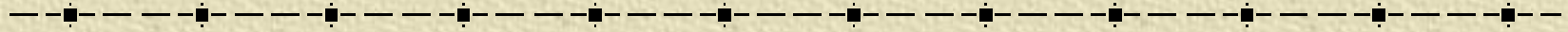
E-Mails

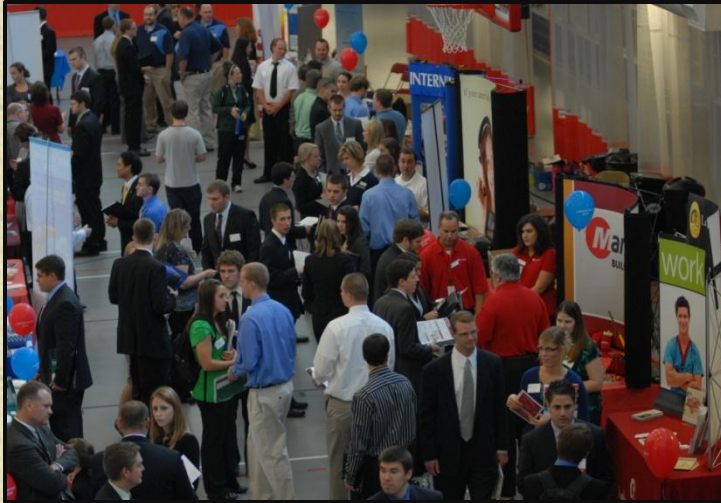

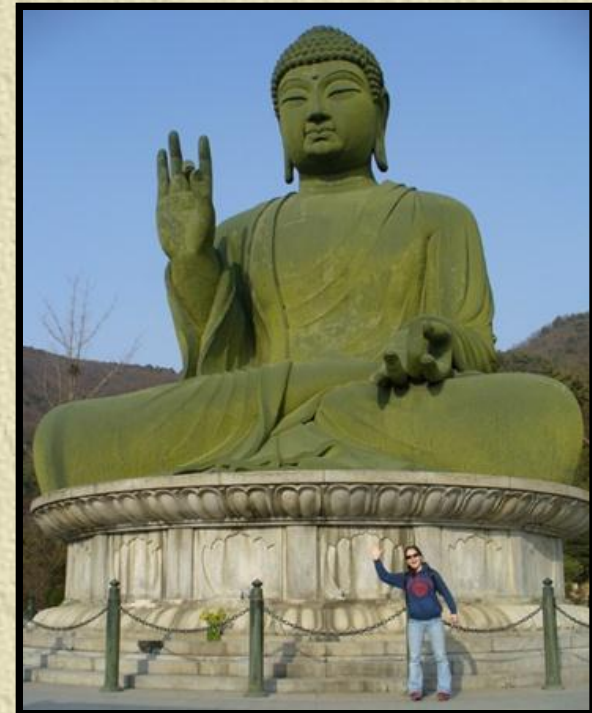
