Colonel Rollin "Rollie" L. Miller was commissioned in 1993 as a Military Intelligence Officer and a Distinguished Military Graduate from Shippensburg, a Masters of Arts in Military Studies from the Marine Corps University and a Master's of Science in National Security and Strategic Resourcing from the Eisenhower School. Colonel Miller is also a graduate of the Marine Corps Command and Staff College.

From 2002 to 2003 he served as the Special Assistant to the Assistant Secretary of Defense for International Security Affairs in the Pentagon. In 2003 Colonel Miller was assigned to the Department of the Army G-2's Intelligence Initiatives Group.

In 2005, Colonel Miller was assigned to the 650th Military Intelligence Group/Allied Command Counterintelligence, SHAPE, Belgium. From 2005 to 2008 Colonel Miller served as the Group S-3 Commander, Afghanistan Detachment for Counterintelligence, and Group Deputy Commander.

In 2008, Colonel Miller deployed to Kuwait as the Director of Installation Support, Area Support Group – Kuwait. From 2009 to 2011, he commanded Base Support Battalion – North, Kuwait. Following Battalion Command, he was assigned to the Army Chief of Staff's office, Senior Leader Development. Form 2011 to 2013, he served as the FA34 and MI Colonels Human Resource Manager, and later as the Chief of Operations Support Division. Following these assignments, Colonel Miller was selected for a Brigade Command and from 2013 to 2015, he commanded the Garrison at Soto Cano Airbase, Honduras.

Colonel Miller is a graduate of the Installation Management Pre-Command Course, Counterintelligence Special Agent Course, J2X Course, Electronic Warfare Officer Course, Combined Arms and Staff Services School, Infantry Officer Advance Course, Military Basic Intelligence Course, Jumpmaster and Basic Airborne Courses, Air Movement Operations Course, and Air Assault Course.
