



Joining “shipsecure” from a Windows 8 or 8.1 PC


1. From the desktop, right-click on the wireless network indicator in the system tray. Click on **Open Network and Sharing Center**.



2. Click on **Set up a new connection or network**.




3. Select **Manually connect to a wireless network** and click on **Next**.



4. Enter the following information:
Network name: shipsecure
Security type: WPA2-Enterprise
Other settings: Make sure **Start this connection automatically** is check marked

Click on **Next**.



5. Click on **Change connection settings**.





6. Click on the **Security** tab, and then on the **Settings** button.




7. *Uncheck* the following settings:

- **Verify the server's identity by validating the certificate**
- **Enable Fast Reconnect**

Click on **Configure**.




8. **Uncheck Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any)** and click on **OK**.




9. Click **OK** at the “Protected EAP Properties window.

10. Click on **Advanced Settings**.





11. Check **Specify authentication mode** and select **User or computer authentication** from the drop-down list.



12. Click **OK** on the “Advanced Settings” window.
13. Click **OK** on the “shipsecure Wireless Network Properties” window.
14. Click **Close** on the “Successfully added shipsecure” window.

To connect to shipsecure:

- Click on the wireless indicator in the system tray.
- Select the **shipsecure** network and make sure **Connect automatically** is selected. Click on **Connect**.
- Enter your Ship username (i.e. “ab1234”) and password.
- Click **OK**.



You will only need to complete these steps **one time** in order to connect to shipsecure. Your laptop or tablet will automatically reconnect each time you enter the range of the Ship wireless network!
