**Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program**

The General Education Program at Shippensburg University comprises 45 of the credit hours required for graduation. It consists of 5 themes with 2-3 required course goals in each theme

- Foundations: 15 credits (3 credit first-year seminar not required for transfer students with at least 30 credits)
  - Writing<sup>W</sup>, Oral Communication<sup>O</sup>, History<sup>H</sup>, Quantitative<sup>Q</sup>
- Interconnections: 9 credits required from 3 goals with at least 3 credits required in Diversity and 3 credits in Global Perspectives
  - Diversity<sup>D</sup>, Global Perspectives<sup>G</sup>, Foreign Language<sup>F</sup>
- Citizenship & Responsibility: 6 credits required with no more than 1 course from the same goal category
  - Citizenship<sup>S</sup>, Ethical Reasoning<sup>E</sup>, Critical Reasoning<sup>R</sup>
- Natural World & Technology: 9 credits required with at least 6 credits completed in the Natural World category
  - Natural World<sup>N</sup>, Technology<sup>T</sup>
- Creativity & Expression: 6 credits required with at least 3 credits required in the Literature category
  - Literature<sup>L</sup>, Arts<sup>A</sup>, Creative<sup>C</sup>

<b>Major Requirements – Business Administration Core (17-20 credits)</b>
BUSN 101 Foundations of Business Administration – 2 credits
ECON 280 Managerial Economics – 3 credits
FINA 311 Financial Management – 3 credits
SCMG 330 Supply Chain and Operations Management – 3 credits
MGMT 447 Business and Society – 3 credits
MGMT 497 Strategic Management – 3 credits
ITAN 300 Information Technology and Business Operations – 3 credits (Required Technology Gen Ed for Accounting)
<b>Major/Concentration Requirements (18-24 credits)</b>
Major credits vary by discipline and require 6-8 courses in addition to the Business Administration Core Requirements. Specific major requirements can be found at in the <a href="#">Shippensburg University Course Catalog</a>
<b>Electives (0-23 credits)</b>
Students should consult with their Ship Academic Advisor to discuss the possibility of completing additional credit toward a minor or 2 <sup>nd</sup> major in the College of Business.

**NOTES (IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ):**

- 0-Level courses do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer.
- Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor if you have any questions. A transfer counselor form SU visits HACC campuses on a regular basis throughout the academic year. Call the SU Office of Admissions for the specific day and time.
- Completion of an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will result in the waiver of remaining general education requirements at SU; as a result, any course can be chosen for this category. Required major gen eds and major coursework will be listed as needed/permitted in this guide. Please consult with the SU transfer advisor with any questions.
- Shippensburg University’s Grove College of Business offers the following majors and concentrations: **Accounting, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Personal Financial Planning, Information Systems and Analytics, Management, International Management, Human Resource Management, Marketing Management, Digital Marketing and Analytics, Supply Chain Management, and Logistics Management.** Business courses not listed on this transfer guide are not accepted as a substitute for specific course requirements at Shippensburg. Free elective credit may be awarded for these courses if free electives are available in the student’s program.
- HACC MATH 110/SU MATH 181 is the required highest-level Math for all business majors. Students who must take MATH 103 as a pre-requisite can count it as an elective for the AS degree.
- A “C” grade or higher is required in ENGL 101 in order to transfer and receive transfer credit.
- The information in this guide may be subject to change. Therefore, students are advised to note the date on the guide and periodically check with the HACC Advising Center for an updated guide. Students are also advised to use this guide with the assistance of a HACC Counselor/Advisor. Following this guide does not guarantee transfer of credit or admission to Shippensburg University.**
