**Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program**

The General Education Program at Shippensburg University comprises 45 of the credit hours required for graduation. It consists of 5 themes with 2-3 required course goals in each theme

-Foundations: 15 credits (3 credit first-year seminar not currently required for transfer students)

- Writing<sup>W</sup>, Oral Communication<sup>O</sup>, History<sup>H</sup>, Quantitative<sup>Q</sup>

-Interconnections: 9 credits required from 3 goals with at least 3 credits required in Diversity and 3 credits in Global Perspectives

- Diversity<sup>D</sup>, Global Perspectives<sup>G</sup>, Foreign Language<sup>F</sup>

-Citizenship & Responsibility: 6 credits required with no more than 1 course from the same goal category

- Citizenship<sup>S</sup>, Ethical Reasoning<sup>E</sup>, Critical Reasoning<sup>R</sup>

-Natural World & Technology: 9 credits required with at least 6 credits completed in the Natural World category

- Natural World<sup>N</sup>, Technology<sup>T</sup>

-Creativity & Expression: 6 credits required with at least 3 credits required in the Literature category

- Literature<sup>L</sup>, Arts<sup>A</sup>, Creative<sup>C</sup>

<b>COURSES TO BE COMPLETED AT SHIPPENSBURG UNIVERSITY (59 credits)</b>
<b>Major Requirements – Psychology Core Courses (12 credits)</b>
Developmental or Social/Personality or Psychopathology or Neuroscience – Choose 2 courses based on remaining requirement – 6 credits
Cognition/S&P – Choose 1: PSYC 323 Sensation & Perception or PSYC 325 Psychology Human Cognition - 3 credits
Learning/Behavioral – Choose 1: PSYC 235 Cond. & Learning or PSYC 383 Social Learning in Infants and Children - 3 credits
Research Methods – PSYC 104 Research Methods in Psychology (waived with completion of PSYC 241 & PSYC 242)
<b>Major Requirements – Electives (12 credits)</b> Students will select at least 6 credits from each of the following categories: Ethical & Social Responsibility in a Diverse World and Professional Development
<b>Major Requirement – Capstone (3 credits)</b>
<b>Electives (0-32 credits)</b>
Students should consult with their Ship Academic Advisor to discuss the possibility of completing additional credit toward a minor/s or 2 <sup>nd</sup> major.

**SPECIAL NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)**

1. 0-Level courses do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer.
2. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor if you have any questions. A transfer counselor from SU visits HACC campuses on a regular basis throughout the academic year. Call the SU Office of Admissions for the specific day and time.
3. Completion of an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will result in the waiver of remaining general education requirements at SU; as a result, any course can be chosen for this category. Required major gen eds and major coursework will be listed as needed/permitted in this guide. Please consult with the SU transfer advisor with any questions.
4. Psychology at SHIP requires a 2.0 cumulative GPA to gain admission.
5. B.A. students must satisfy the Novice level competency in a foreign language. This is accomplished via 3 years of the same language in high school, an AP score of at least 3, or the completion of a 103 level course. Three credits of a foreign language may count under the Interconnections Foreign Language general education requirement.
6. Completion of PSYC 241 and PSYC 242 at HACC will result in the waiver of PSYC 104 upon matriculation to SU.
7. **The information in this guide may be subject to change. Therefore, students are advised to note the date on the guide and periodically check with the HACC Advising Center for an updated guide. Students are also advised to use this guide with the assistance of a HACC Counselor/Advisor. Following this guide does not guarantee transfer of credit or admission to Shippensburg University.**
