General Education Requirements: Per BOG Transfer Policy 1999-01-A, completion of an A.A. or A.S. degree will result in the waiver of remaining general education requirements at Ship resulting in the availability of additional free elective credits that must be completed to graduate with the minimum 120 credits required for the bachelor's degree.

Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program

The General Education Program at Shippensburg University comprises 45 of the credit hours required for graduation. It consists of 5 themes with 2-3 required course goals in each theme

-Foundations: 15 credits (3 credit first-year seminar not currently required for transfer students)

- Writing^W, Oral Communication^O, History^H, Quantitative^Q

-Interconnections: 9 credits required from 3 goals with at least 3 credits required in Diversity and 3 credits in Global Perspectives

- Diversity^D, Global Perspectives^G, Foreign Language^F

-Citizenship & Responsibility: 6 credits required with no more than 1 course from the same goal category

- Citizenship^S, Ethical Reasoning^E, Critical Reasoning^R

-Natural World & Technology: 9 credits required with at least 6 credits completed in the Natural World category

- Natural World^N, Technology^T

-Creativity & Expression: 6 credits required with at least 3 credits required in the Literature category

- Literature^L, Arts^A, Creative^C

SPECIAL NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)

1. 0-Level courses do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer.
2. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor if you have any questions. A transfer counselor from SU visits HACC campuses on a regular basis throughout the academic year. Call the SU Office of Admissions for the specific day and time.
3. Completion of an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will result in the waiver of remaining general education requirements at SU; as a result, any course can be chosen for this category. Required major gen eds and major coursework will be listed as needed/permitted in this guide. Please consult with the SU transfer advisor with any questions.
4. The History B.A. major at SU requires a minimum 2.0 GPA to declare. The B.S.Ed requires a minimum 3.0 GPA to declare.
5. B.A. students must attain proficiency in a foreign language. Proficiency may be satisfied by completing a language class at the 103 level, three years of one foreign language in high school, or AP or CLEP testing. Three credits of a foreign language may count toward the Interconnections General Education requirements.
6. MATH 202 (MATH 117 at SU) is recommended for B.S.Ed majors. PSYC 101, ECON 201, GEOG 201, PSPL 101 and SOCI 201 (SU PSYC 101, ECON 101, GEOG 101, POLI 100, and SOCI 101) are **required** of B.S.Ed majors only.
7. **The information in this guide may be subject to change. Students are advised to note the date on the guide and periodically check with the HACC Advising Center for an updated guide, as well as use this guide with the assistance of a HACC Counselor/Advisor. Following this guide does not guarantee transfer of credit or admission to Shippensburg University.**
