Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program

The General Education Program at Shippensburg University comprises 45 of the credit hours required for graduation. It consists of 5 themes with 2-3 required course goals in each theme

- Foundations: 15 credits (3 credit first-year seminar not required for transfer students with at least 30 credits)
 - Writing^W, Oral Communication^O, History^H, Quantitative^Q
- Interconnections: 9 credits required from 3 goals with at least 3 credits required in Diversity and 3 credits in Global Perspectives
 - Diversity^D, Global Perspectives^G, Foreign Language^F
- Citizenship & Responsibility: 6 credits required with no more than 1 course from the same goal category
 - Citizenship^S, Ethical Reasoning^E, Critical Reasoning^R
- Natural World & Technology: 9 credits required with at least 6 credits completed in the Natural World category
 - Natural World^N, Technology^T
- Creativity & Expression: 6 credits required with at least 3 credits required in the Literature category
 - Literature^L, Arts^A, Creative^C

COURSES TO BE COMPLETED AT SHIPPENSBURG UNIVERSITY
General Education Requirements: Per BOG Transfer Policy 1999-01-A, completion of an A.A. or A.S. degree from HACC will result in the waiver of the remainder of the general education requirements at Ship. This will result in the availability of additional free elective credits that must be completed to graduate with the minimum 120 credits required for the bachelor's degree.
Major Requirements – Business Administration Core (17 credits)
BSN 101 Foundations of Business Administration – 2 credits
ECO 280 Managerial Economics – 3 credits
FIN 311 Financial Management – 3 credits
MGT 447 Business and Society – 3 credits
MGT 497 Strategic Management – 3 credits
SCM 330 Supply Chain and Operations Management – 3 credits
Major/Concentration Requirements (18-21 credits)
Major credits vary by discipline and require 6-7 courses in addition to the Business Administration Core Requirements. Specific major requirements can be found at https://catalog.ship.edu/content.php?catoid=12&navoid=275
Electives (20-23 credits)
Students should consult with their Ship Academic Advisor to discuss the possibility of completing additional credit toward a minor or 2 nd major in the College of Business.

NOTES (IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ):

- Shippensburg University's Grove College of Business offers the following majors and concentrations: **Accounting, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Personal Financial Planning, Information Systems and Analytics, Management, International Management, Human Resource Management, Marketing Management, Digital Marketing and Analytics, Supply Chain Management, and Logistics Management.** The AACSB International, the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business, internationally accredits these majors. Because of this accreditation, business courses not listed on this transfer guide are not accepted as a substitute for specific course requirements at Shippensburg. Free elective credit may be awarded for these courses if free electives are available in the student's program.
- HACC MATH 110/SU MATH 181 is the required highest level Math for all business majors. Students who must take MATH 103 as a pre-requisite can count it as an elective for the AS degree.
- A "C" grade or higher is required in ENG 101 in order to transfer and receive transfer credit.
- The information in this guide may be subject to change. Therefore students are advised to note the date on the guide and periodically check in the HACC Advising Center for an updated guide. Students are also advised to use this guide with the assistance of an HACC Counselor/Advisor. Following this guide does not guarantee transfer of credit or admission to Shippensburg University.**
