Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program

The General Education Program at Shippensburg University comprises 45 of the credit hours required for graduation. It consists of 5 themes with 2-3 required course goals in each theme

-Foundations: 15 credits (3 credit first-year seminar not currently required for transfer students)

- Writing^W, Oral Communication^O, History^H, Quantitative^Q

-Interconnections: 9 credits required from 3 goals with at least 3 credits required in Diversity and 3 credits in Global Perspectives

- Diversity^D, Global Perspectives^G, Foreign Language^F

-Citizenship & Responsibility: 6 credits required with no more than 1 course from the same goal category

- Citizenship^S, Ethical Reasoning^E, Critical Reasoning^R

-Natural World & Technology: 9 credits required with at least 6 credits completed in the Natural World category

- Natural World^N, Technology^T

-Creativity & Expression: 6 credits required with at least 3 credits required in the Literature category

- Literature^L, Arts^A, Creative^C

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COURSES TO BE COMPLETED AT SHIPPENSBURG UNIVERSITY (59 credits)
General Education Requirements: Per BOG Transfer Policy 1999-01-A, completion of an A.A. or A.S. degree from HACC will result in the waiver of the remainder of the general education requirements at Ship. This will result in the availability of additional free elective credits that must be completed to graduate with the minimum 120 credits required for the bachelor's degree.
Major Requirements - Required Core Courses (9 credits)
CRJ 309 Theories of Crime and Crime Control – 3 credits
CRJ 310 Research Methods – 3 credits
CRJ 452 Race, Ethnicity, and Crime – 3 credits
Major Requirements – Criminal Justice Electives (21 credits) Students will select at least 7 CRJ courses at the 300 or 400 level
Major Requirement – Capstone (3 credits): CRJ 454 Policy, Professionalism, and Ethics – 3 credits
Major Requirement – Interdisciplinary Courses (9 credits): Students must take at least 3 courses/9 credits at the 200 level or higher in any discipline except Criminal Justice or Military Science.
Electives (17 credits)
Students should consult with their Ship Academic Advisor to discuss the possibility of completing additional credit toward a minor.

NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)

1. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. This guide should be used with the assistance of a HACC Counselor/Advisor. Following the guide does not guarantee transfer of credit or admission into Shippensburg University. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer advisor if you have any questions.
2. Criminal Justice courses must have a grade of "C" or better to transfer to Shippensburg and a 2.6 cumulative GPA is required in order to be granted admission into the program.
