Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program

The General Education Program at Shippensburg University comprises 45 of the credit hours required for graduation. It consists of 5 themes with 2-3 required course goals in each theme

-Foundations: 15 credits (3 credit first-year seminar not currently required for transfer students)

- Writing^W, Oral Communication^O, History^H, Quantitative^Q

-Interconnections: 9 credits required from 3 goals with at least 3 credits required in Diversity and 3 credits in Global Perspectives

- Diversity^D, Global Perspectives^G, Foreign Language^F

-Citizenship & Responsibility: 6 credits required with no more than 1 course from the same goal category

- Citizenship^S, Ethical Reasoning^E, Critical Reasoning^R

-Natural World & Technology: 9 credits required with at least 6 credits completed in the Natural World category

- Natural World^N, Technology^T

-Creativity & Expression: 6 credits required with at least 3 credits required in the Literature category

- Literature^L, Arts^A, Creative^C

SPECIAL NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)

1. Students must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA to gain admission into the PreK-4 program. 0-Level courses do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer.
2. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor if you have any questions. A transfer counselor from SU visits HACC campuses on a regular basis throughout the academic year. Call the SU Office of Admissions for the specific day and time.
3. Shippensburg University uses an electronic portfolio system. Please maintain electronic copies of all of your education course work to upload to a portfolio when you transfer to Shippensburg.
4. **The information in this guide may be subject to change. Students are advised to note the date on the guide and periodically check with the HACC Advising Center for an updated guide, as well as use this guide with the assistance of a HACC Counselor/Advisor. Following this guide does not guarantee transfer of credit or admission to Shippensburg University.**

CLEARANCE INFORMATION

Education majors take courses that often require field experiences in local schools. Consequently, they are required to complete and submit annual clearances, which include the following:

- PA Criminal Background Check
- Child Abuse
- FBI Fingerprinting
- TB Testing
- Liability Insurance (can be purchased with membership to PSEA)
- ACTs 24/82 Form
- National Sex Offender
- Mandated Reporter Training
- Additional clearances, may be required for specific placements

Clearances must be submitted to the Office of Partnerships, Professional Experiences and Outreach (OPPEO). Reminders will be sent through email. Pay special attention to messages from fieldexperiences@ship.edu or Kelly Ile.
