Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program

The General Education Program at Shippensburg University comprises 45 of the credit hours required for graduation. It consists of 5 themes with 2-3 required course goals in each theme

- -Foundations: 15 credits (3 credit first-year seminar not currently required for transfer students)
 - Writing^W, Oral Communication^O, History^H, Quantitative^Q
- -Interconnections: 9 credits required from 3 goals with at least 3 credits required in Diversity and 3 credits in Global Perspectives
 - Diversity^D, Global Perspectives^G, Foreign Language^F
- -Citizenship & Responsibility: 6 credits required with no more than 1 course from the same goal category
 - Citizenship^S, Ethical Reasoning^E, Critical Reasoning^R
- -Natural World & Technology: 9 credits required with at least 6 credits completed in the Natural World category
 - Natural World^N, Technology^T
- -Creativity & Expression: 6 credits required with at least 3 credits required in the Literature category
 - Literature^L, Arts^A, Creative^C

NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)

- 1. Additional transfer credits may be taken at HACC for transfer to Shippensburg. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SHIP transfer advisor for advisement on additional coursework.
- 2. 0-Level courses do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer.
- 3. The Exercise Science B.S. at SHIP allows 10-20 free electives, depending on internship credits done at SHIP
- 4. The Exercise Science major offers two different concentrations, Allied Health Pre-Professional and Human Performance & Fitness. The transfer requirements for the Allied Health Pre-Professional Concentration are the completion of 15 credits, a QPA of 2.50 or higher, and BIO 161 or 162 or 237 completed with a C or better. The transfer requirements for the Human Performance & Fitness Concentration are 15 credits, QPA of 2.00 or higher, and any BIO, CHM, or PHY course completed with a C or higher. Selection is competitive and students will be selected from those who fulfill the above requirements. It is strongly recommended that the equivalents of BIO 237 and BIO 238 (Anatomy and Physiology I and II) be completed prior to transferring.
- 5. BIO 238, ESC 150, ESC 244, ESC 260, and MAT 117 (HACC BIOL 122, EXSC 102, EXSC 202, NUTR 104, and MATH 202) must be completed with a C or higher.
- 6. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and SHIP. However, curricula are subject to change. This guide should be used with the assistance of a HACC Counselor/Advisor. Following the guide does not guarantee transfer of credit or admission into Shippensburg University. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SHIP transfer advisor if you have any questions. A transfer advisor from Shippensburg University visits the HACC campus regularly throughout the academic year. Call the SHIP Office of Admissions or check the SHIP website at www.ship.edu for the specific day and time.
- 7. Students who intend to go to graduate school in the health professions (i.e. Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, etc.) should finish the Physics and Chemistry sequence by taking CHEM 102 w lab and PHYS 202 w lab. Students should work with their advisor in taking remaining required program specific electives.
