Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program

The General Education Program at Shippensburg University comprises 45 of the credit hours required for graduation. It consists of 5 themes with 2-3 required course goals in each theme

- -Foundations: 15 credits (3 credit first-year seminar not currently required for transfer students)
 - Writing^W, Oral Communication^O, History^H, Quantitative^Q
- -Interconnections: 9 credits required from 3 goals with at least 3 credits required in Diversity and 3 credits in Global Perspectives
 - Diversity^D, Global Perspectives^G, Foreign Language^F
- -Citizenship & Responsibility: 6 credits required with no more than 1 course from the same goal category
 - Citizenship^S, Ethical Reasoning^E, Critical Reasoning^R
- -Natural World & Technology: 9 credits required with at least 6 credits completed in the Natural World category
 - Natural World^N, Technology^T
- -Creativity & Expression: 6 credits required with at least 3 credits required in the Literature category
 - Literature^L, Arts^A, Creative^C

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COURSES TO BE COMPLETED AT SHIPPENSBURG UNIVERSITY (59 credits)

General Education Requirements: Per BOG Transfer Policy 1999-01-A, completion of an A.A. or A.S. degree from HACC will result in the waiver of the remainder of the general education requirements at Ship. This will result in the availability of additional free elective credits that must be completed to graduate with the minimum 120 credits required for the bachelor's degree.

Major Requirements - Psychology Core Courses (12 credits)

Social/Personality or Abnormal - Choose 1 course based on remaining requirement - 3 credits

Neuroscience - Choose 1: PSY 320 Behavioral Neuroscience or PSY 333 Psyc Attention & Consciousness - 3 credits

Cognition/S&P - Choose 1: PSY 323 Sensation & Perception or PSY 325 Psychology Human Cognition - 3 credits

Learning/Behavioral - Choose 1: PSY 235 Cond. & Learning or PSY 383 Child's Understand Social World - 3 credits

Major Requirements - Electives (12 credits) Students will select at least 2 electives from each of the following categories: Ethical & Social Responsibility in a Diverse World and Professional Development

Major Requirement - Capstone (3 credits)

Electives (32 credits)

Students should consult with their Ship Academic Advisor to discuss the possibility of completing additional credit toward a minor or 2nd major.

SPECIAL NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)

- 1. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor if you have any questions.
- 2. Psychology at SHIP requires a 2.0 cumulative GPA in order to gain admission.
- 3. B.A. students must satisfy the Novice level competency in a foreign language. This is accomplished via 3 years of the same language in high school, an AP score of at least 3, or the completion of a 103 level course. Three credits of a foreign language may count under the Interconnections Foreign Language general education requirement.
- 4. Students who take PSYC 241 and PSYC 242 at HACC will receive transfer credit for PSY 205 and PSY 301 at SHIP (the requirement for PSY 105 will be waived). If students only take PSYC 241 at HACC they will only receive credit for PSY 105 at Ship.
