Through working with our campus partners, GSAB is proud to announce a service that is available to Graduate Assistants: ***Special Parking Requests!*** Please read the following instructions below:

“All vehicles parked on campus must display a parking pass. If an event necessitates a GA to park somewhere other than where their decal permits, they should simply call the police department (717-477-1444) and let the officer know. If they have no type of parking pass/decal, they will need to get a temporary pass (Police Station-Reed Operations Center) and park where advised.”
