## Before you arrive to campus

**Log into MyHousing in the MyShip portal.** View your housing assignment and roommate information before Thursday, August 24.

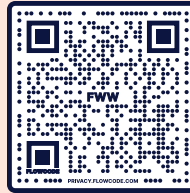
**Pack—and don't forget your SU student ID!**

The labels will help crews quickly identify where to deliver your items. Fill out the information on each label as soon as you confirm your housing assignment in the MyHousing section of the MyShip portal. ## When you arrive on campus

**Check into your residence hall and move in!** (View schedule for times ▶)

We organize check-in times by hall and home zip code. Directions to campus, as well as your check-in time, are on the back of the enclosed **RED** and **BLUE** cards. Campus police and volunteers will be ready to help direct you. To expedite this process, please place the **BLUE** card on your dashboard if you are moving into Kieffer, Lackhove, Harley, or McCune halls. Place the **RED** card on your dashboard if you are moving into Seavers, Naugle, or McLean halls. *Please have ID available—your student ID (if you already have it), a driver's license, or any other photo ID.*

**Get your SU Student ID** | 9:00AM–6:00PM | CUB 125 (Airport Lounge)

If you did not receive an SU ID this summer at orientation or were not able to attend orientation, get your ID picture taken and receive your ID here.

**Vehicle registration** | 9:00AM–6:00PM | CUB 125 (Airport Lounge)

Students who completed the vehicle registration can pick up their parking passes at the CUB 125 (Airport Lounge). Please bring SU ID.

**Pick up your mailbox key** | CUB/The UPS Store

Visit the UPS Store toward the rear of the CUB, and pick up your mailbox key.

**Resource area for troubleshooting (RAFT)** | 9:00AM–6:00PM | CUB, first floor
