As indicated in the ESA Policy and the Service Animal Guidelines, students are responsible for proper disposal of their animal's waste. These procedures are necessary for the general health and well-being of the animals and members of our campus community.

Designated waste receptacles have been placed in each residence hall. Containers are grey in color, have lids, and will be lined with trash bags.

**All waste must be in a waste or trash bag prior to placement in waste receptacles. **

- 1. Harley Hall: first floor trash room
- 2. Kieffer Hall: ground floor trash room
- 3. Lackhove Hall: ground floor trash room
- 4. McLean Hall: next to the dock doors
- 5. McCune Hall: ground floor trash room
- 6. Mowrey Hall: outside on the dock
- 7. Naugle Hall/Seavers Hall: outside the Seaver's exterior trash room door

Failure to adhere to these procedures will result in disciplinary action. This can include, but not limited to, damage/clean-up fees being charged to the student, request for the animal to be removed from campus, and/or conduct referral to the Dean of Student's office.
