Eugene B. Mizdail II, born and raised in Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania graduated from Cumberland Valley High School in 1983. He was commissioned as a Field Artillery Officer in 1987 through the Shippensburg University's Army ROTC program. He graduated in 1987 with a Bachelor's of Science in Public Administration. Eugene B. Mizdail II, served in the Pennsylvania Army National Guard from 15 May 1987 until 15 September 2012. He served in various assignments throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania including having the distinction of being the fourth generation member of his family to serve in the historical unit of the 1-109th Field Artillery in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania. Upon his retirement he received a state promotion to the rank of Colonel.

Eugene B. Mizdail II worked as a sales representative for D & H Distributing, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania from 1989 until 2001. On January 25, 2001 he returned to Shippensburg University's Army ROTC program as the Recruiting Operations Officer a position he held until September 26, 2013. During this time he mentored and enrolled numerous Cadets in the program. Over his 13 years in the Military Science Department he also served as an instructor, military science instructor, military history course, and deployed to Ft. Lewis, WA to support Warrior Forge on multiple occasions. 151 Officers received their commissions as Army Officers under the guidance of Eugene B. Mizdail II.
