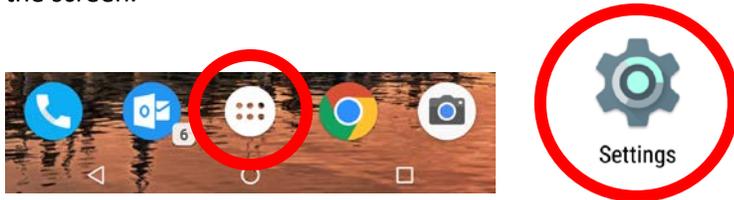
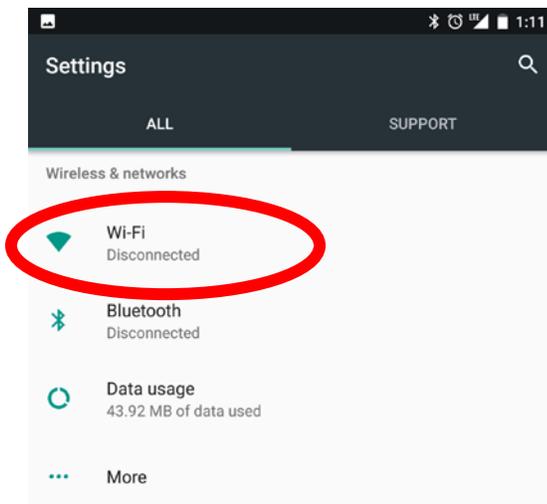


Joining “shipsecure” from an Android device

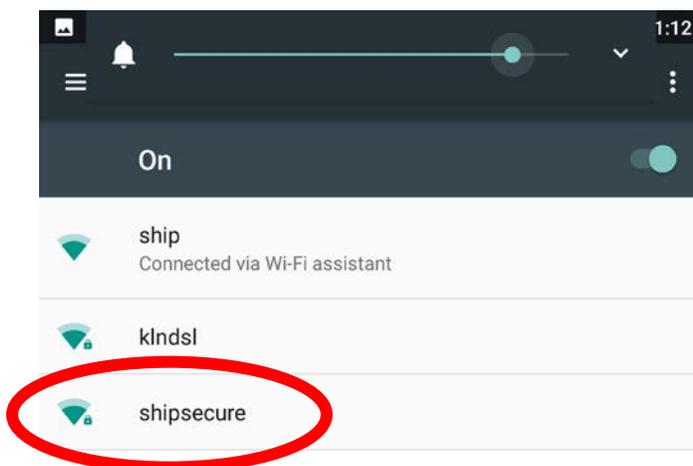
1. From the home screen, tap on **Settings**. You may need to first tap on the “Apps” button in the bottom center of the screen.



2. Tap on **Wi-Fi** in the settings list.

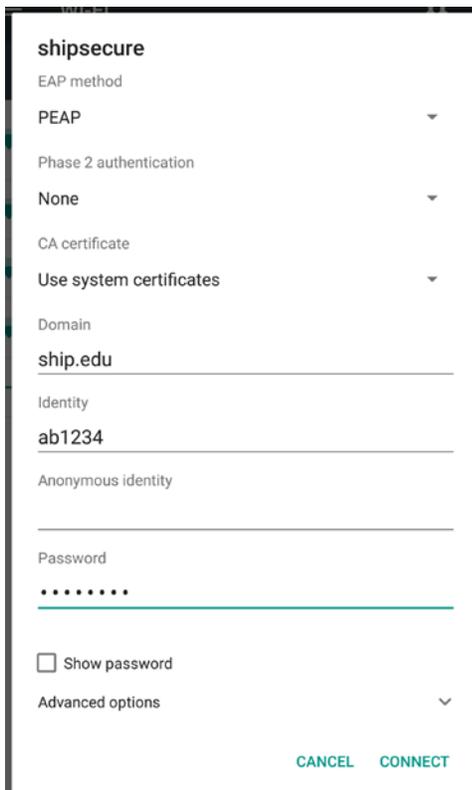


3. Make sure Wi-Fi is turned on, and then tap on the **shipsecure** wireless network.

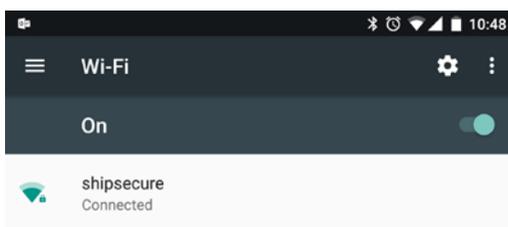


- On the screen that appears, enter the following
CA certificate: Use system certificates
Domain: ship.edu
Identity: *your Ship username* (i.e. ab1234)
Password: *your Ship password*

Tap on **Connect**.



- You should now see the status listed as “Connected” under the shipsecure network.



You are now connected to the **shipsecure** wireless network.
Your Android device should automatically reconnect to this network when in range.
