Joining "shipsecure" from an Android device

1. From the home screen, tap on **Settings**. You may need to first tap on the "Apps" button in the bottom center of the screen.



2. Tap on Wi-Fi in the settings list.



3. Make sure Wi-Fi is turned on, and then tap on the **shipsecure** wireless network.



On the screen that appears, enter the following
CA certificate: Use system certificates
Domain: ship.edu
Identity: your Ship username (i.e. ab1234)
Password: your Ship password

Tap on **Connect**.

5. You should now see the status listed as "Connected" under the shipsecure network.
